Grain Inspection Fees and Charges

Effective Date: February 15, 2022. The Federal Grain Inspection Service (FGIS) must approve all fees for official services and Official Agencies (OAs) will assess only those fees appearing on their current approved fee schedule. State and local taxes will be added as required.

Regular Hours and Hourly Rates: Iowa Lab: 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., New Jersey, Georgia and South Carolina Labs: 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (first eight consecutive hours within regular business hour), Monday through Friday, except Holidays. All hourly charges will be assessed in quarter hour increments, per individual necessary to perform the service.

Iowa: Inspector / Technician / Weigher / Sampler: \$27.56/hour

New Jersey: Inspector / Sampler / Technician / Weigher: \$47.19 / hour

Georgia and South Carolina: Inspector / Sampler / Technician / Weigher: \$36.28 / hour

Onsite Lab Staffing: Applicable hourly rate, per person and is subject to overtime, Holiday / Sunday rates. Basis will include travel time, mileage and unit fees.

Overtime Hourly Rate: One and one half regular hourly rate assessed in quarter hour increments in addition to unit fees, for work performed on Saturday and other than regular hours.

Holiday / Sunday Hourly Rate: Double regular hourly rate assessed in quarter hour increments in addition to unit fees. Holidays are: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and after 12:00 p.m. on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve. The observance of holidays that fall on weekends will follow Federal protocol.

Callout Time: A minimum of 4 hours per person will be assessed at the applicable hourly rate when requests for service are withdrawn or in the event of request resulting in personnel returning to duty after dismissal.

Standby / Travel time: Assessed per individual at applicable hourly rates for applicant caused delays.

Mileage: The Internal Revenue Service standard rate will be the maximum assessed for all services performed basis service point's lab and prorated whenever possible. Any change to the mileage rate is possible when the IRS changes their standard mileage rate.

Personnel Safety: It is the customer's responsibility to make the grain, commodity or stowage area safely accessible. Agency employees do not open or close doors or lids on railcars or shipping containers. There must be a minimum of two people at all times on top of railcars and in the immediate vicinity at facilities where services are being performed. This can be two Agency employees or one Agency employee and one customer employee. This is to 'render aid if needed' or to call for assistance.

Weather Policy: Agency will adhere to the following inclement weather policy: Sampling and stowage examination requests may be delayed, curtailed or dismissed when any of the following conditions exist: High winds, rainfall/snow that creates conditions that are dangerous to employee and/or facility specific conditions that could put employees providing services in jeopardy. Adequate lighting must be provided when onsite services are requested after sunset. Agency will abide by federal, state and local authorities in regard to voluntary and/or mandatory evacuations in the event of severe weather or other natural disasters.

FGIS Administrative Tonnage Fees. In addition to all other applicable fees, FGIS administrative tonnage fees for export grain shipments inspected and/or weighed, excluding land carrier shipments to Canada and Mexico, will be assessed at the current per metric ton rate identified in FGIS Directive 9180.74 Service Fees and Billing Codes, Attachment 1. Invoices will identify assessed administrative tonnage fees as separate line items per applicable carrier/unit type.

FGIS Supervision Fees. In addition to all other applicable fees, FGIS supervision fees for domestic U.S. grain shipments inspected and/or weighed, including land carrier shipments to Canada and Mexico, will be assessed at the current per metric ton rate identified in FGIS Directive 9180.74 Service Fees and Billing Codes, Attachment 2. Invoices will identify assessed supervision fees as separate line items per applicable carrier/unit type.

Grain Grading Seminars may be negotiated. The cost will be \$84.00 per hour for each instructor, plus mileage and \$10.50 per attendee. Maximum four attendees per instructor.

Toll road charges will be charged back to applicants as they occur.

Other expenses such as mileage, sample delivery, postage, etc., will be charged for other services not covered under the USGSA in addition to the unit fees listed in the schedule. Per diem of \$52.50 plus \$157.50 hotel charge (or actual cost of hotel), per person for overnight assignments. If Agency's FedEx account is used for shipping there will be a 10% markup added.
